





Cooking Club (Cupcakes)	<p>Families work together to cook a delicious recipe using a step by step demonstration. Cooking together can help develop listening skills, waiting skills and help towards confidence building. Children will be offered the opportunity to use their fine motor skills and indulge in sensory experiences through touching ingredients. Come Dine with Me	<p>This activity is aimed at supporting children and young people become familiar with ordering food from a menu, when going out for meals. We will be using role play techniques.</p> <p>Children and young people will bring along a favourite toy/teddy and with the help of the parent/carer will order from a menu a meal of their choice for their favourite toy.
