

## Paper Based Resources to Use at Home

These are some resources that you could use to keep your child busy at home. They are available from Twinkl ([www.twinkl.co.uk](http://www.twinkl.co.uk)). Twinkl usually has a subscription fee but is currently free for parents to access for a month. You will need to register and can download resources to use later. Use the following code to gain free access: **CVDTWINKLHELPS**

These resources will need to be printed out and your child will need a pen/pencil or colouring materials to complete them and in some cases scissors or glue.

**Please supervise your child carefully if they are using scissors.** If you would prefer for your child not to use scissors, cut the pictures up yourself and just ask them to glue them on.

## Colouring

These resources are printable colouring sheets which you can get your child to complete. The sheets at the top are the easiest ones with harder pictures at the bottom. If your child finds it hard to choose a colour, out a dot or colour a small patch using the colour you want them to use for each section to help them know what to do.
