



Structured Teaching Training

A 5-day interactive course based on TEACCH principles.

Audience:

Structured Teaching Training is aimed at senior leaders, curriculum managers, teachers, speech and language therapists and other professionals working with children and young people who have a diagnosis of Autistic Spectrum Condition. The course encourages active participation as trainees work with pupils in a structured teaching classroom for four days. Trainees will have opportunities to assess pupils' skills; they will learn to organise a structured teaching environment and plan and make structured activities that can be used in both the classroom and during leisure sessions. Trainees will be shown how to introduce a method of teaching that will significantly decrease pupil anxiety and distress, allowing learning to take place.

Training team:

The training team consists of experienced teachers and speech and language therapists who have years of experience in working with pupils and young people with Autistic Spectrum Condition. Trainees will work in small groups and will be led in a supportive way by the trainers.

Overview of the course:

- Day 1:** Nature of Autism, physical structure and assessment
- Day 2:** Assessment and work systems, and Sensory issues
- Day 3:** Moving pupils from supported to independent working
- Day 4:** Communication and attention
- Day 5:** Play, leisure and behaviour
