We devise an individualised programme of study for each pupil, according to the needs identified within their Education, Health and Care Plan.

We offer a range of opportunities and approaches to facilitate meaningful educational experiences for young people with complex needs, including:

A sensory curriculum for young people with profound and complex needs

Structured teaching for young people with Autism Spectrum Disorder and other learning difficulties

Individualised support with challenging behaviour arising from communication difficulties

Access to personalised sensory regulation to support young people in coping with the demands of day-to-day life

Personal care support, including the teaching of simple self-care routines such as washing and dressing

Management of complex medical needs

Speech and Language Therapy

Access to a college link experience for pupils most likely to continue in education post 19

A supported Work Experience placement in Year 14, where appropriate
