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Myths and Legends

Communication and language

As part of this topic we will be learning about Myths and Legends through the themes of Magic and stories. In CLL we are reading the stories of 'How to train your dragon', where students will be encouraged to develop their imagination. This will be followed by 'MacBeth', as the term develops. All stories will be read and explored in a variety of ways including adapted texts and sensory stories. All learning is individualised for students.

Maths

In maths we are learning about numbers, measure and data handling. Students will be supported to develop their understanding of number, individualised to their learning needs. They will also be learning different ways to measure - big and small, longer and shorter and ordering different sized objects. Some students will begin to use standard measuring units such as centimeters and meters. Later in the term, students will work on collecting data and how to display this. All mathematical learning is tailored to individual skills, needs and targets.

Project

In topic, we are learning about myths and legends. Students will learn about Vikings. They will engage with artistic and creative projects to support this. Students will be listening to different sounds and exploring where they come from and how they were made. They will also be exploring mixing, to make a range of new products. Through this project, we aim to extend their horizons and understanding of aspects of life outside of that which is familiar.
